- Do you have a list on your library's website that explains the resources that are available for print-impaired readers, such as GLASS or Bookshare?
- Does your library offer assistive technology to increase access to your collection and resources by vision impaired readers?
- Are you aware of the resources that your library owns that may be accessible to your patrons, such as descriptive narration movies or your library's audiobook collection?
